- iii) His/ Her CR Dossier in original are enclosed/photocopies of the ACRs for the last 5 years duly attested by an officer of the rank of Under Secretary of the Govt. of India or above are enclosed.
- iv) No major/ minor penalty has been imposed on him/ her during the last 10 years Or a list of major/ minor penalties imposed on him/ her during the last 10 years is enclosed. (as the case may be)
